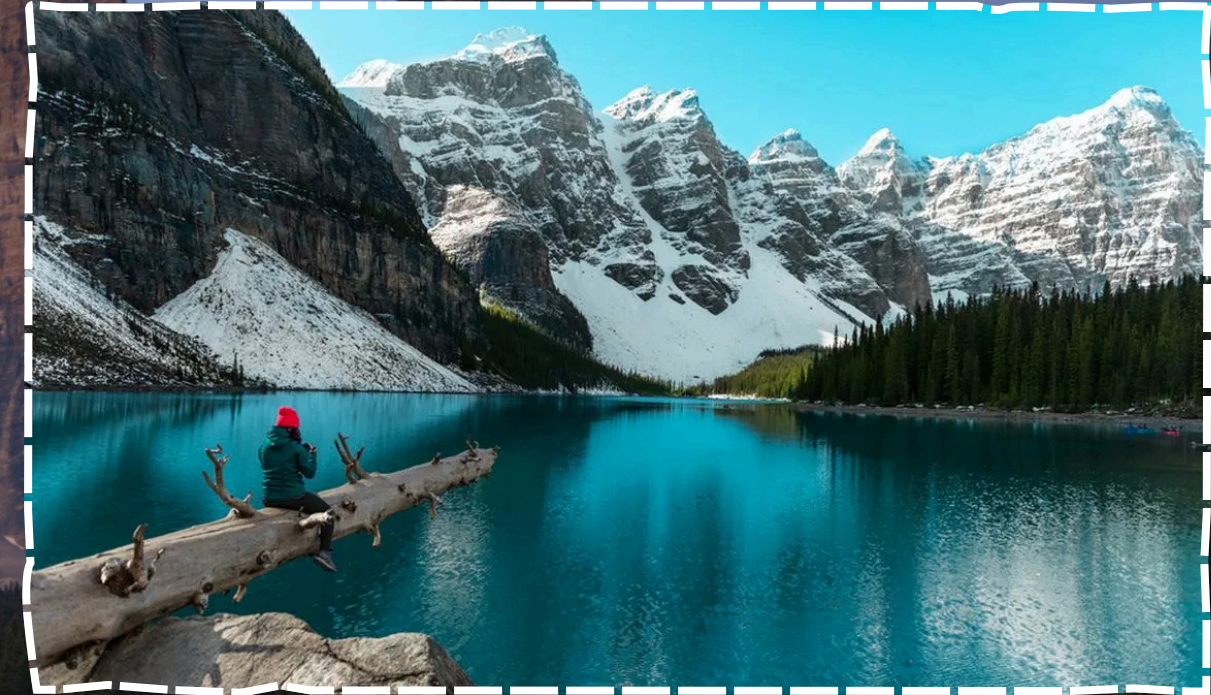

## **NIAGARA FALLS (ONTARIO)**

***Niagara Falls Ontario is a world renowned Canadian city situated on the western bank of the Niagara River, famous for hosting the massive Horseshoe Falls (Canadian Falls). It is a premier year round tourist destination attracting millions annually, offering dramatic views, boat tours, nightlife, casinos and the Clifton Hill amusement area.***



## **BANFF NATIONAL PARK & ROCKY MOUNTAINS (ALBERTA)**

**Banff National Park, established in 1885 in Alberta's Rocky Mountains is Canada's first national park and a UNESCO World Heritage site known for turquoise lakes, glaciers and rugged peaks. Located 110–180 km west of Calgary, it features the town of Banff and Lake Louise, attracting millions annually for hiking, skiing and wildlife viewing.**



## **OLD QUEBEC (QUEBEC CITY)**

**Old Quebec (Vieux-Québec) is a historic UNESCO World Heritage site in Quebec City, Canada recognized as the only fortified city north of Mexico. Founded by Samuel de Champlain in 1608, it serves as the birthplace of French North America, featuring 17th century European architecture, cobblestone streets and 4.6 km of walls surrounding the Upper and Lower Towns.**



## *VANCOUVER & STANLEY PARK (BRITISH COLUMBIA)*

*Stanley Park is a 405-hectare (1,001-acre) public park in Vancouver, British Columbia known as a top ranked urban oasis surrounded by the Burrard Inlet and English Bay. As a National Historic Site of Canada, it offers a blend of lush rainforest trails, beaches, cultural landmarks (like totem poles) and the famous 10km Seawall making it a must visit spot.*



## *CN TOWER & TORONTO (ONTARIO)*

*The CN Tower is Canada's national icon and a defining feature of the Toronto skyline, standing at a height of 553.33 metres (1,815.3 ft). Completed in 1976 by the Canadian National Railway, it was the world's tallest free standing structure for over 30 years and is currently recognized as one of the Seven Wonders of the Modern World.*



## ***BAY OF FUNDY (NEW BRUNSWICK / NOVA SCOTIA)***

*The Bay of Fundy located between New Brunswick and Nova Scotia in Canada is world famous for having the highest tides on Earth, with water levels rising up to 16 meters (52–53 feet) twice daily. This dramatic natural wonder features iconic, carved sea stacks at Hopewell Rocks, diverse whale watching and rich, UNESCO recognized fossil sites along its rugged coast.*

## ***MONTREAL (QUEBEC)***

*Montreal is the largest city in Quebec and the second-largest in Canada, serving as a major cultural, economic and French speaking hub. Located on an island in the St. Lawrence River, it blends European charm with North American energy, renowned for its festivals, gastronomy and historic architecture.*



## **JASPER NATIONAL PARK (ALBERTA)**

*Jasper National Park located in Alberta, Canada is the largest national park in the Canadian Rockies spanning 11,000 of mountain wilderness. Established in 1907 and part of a UNESCO World Heritage Site, it is renowned for the Columbia Icefield glaciers, stunning alpine scenery, abundant wildlife and its status as a massive dark sky preserve.*

## **WHISTLER (BRITISH COLUMBIA)**

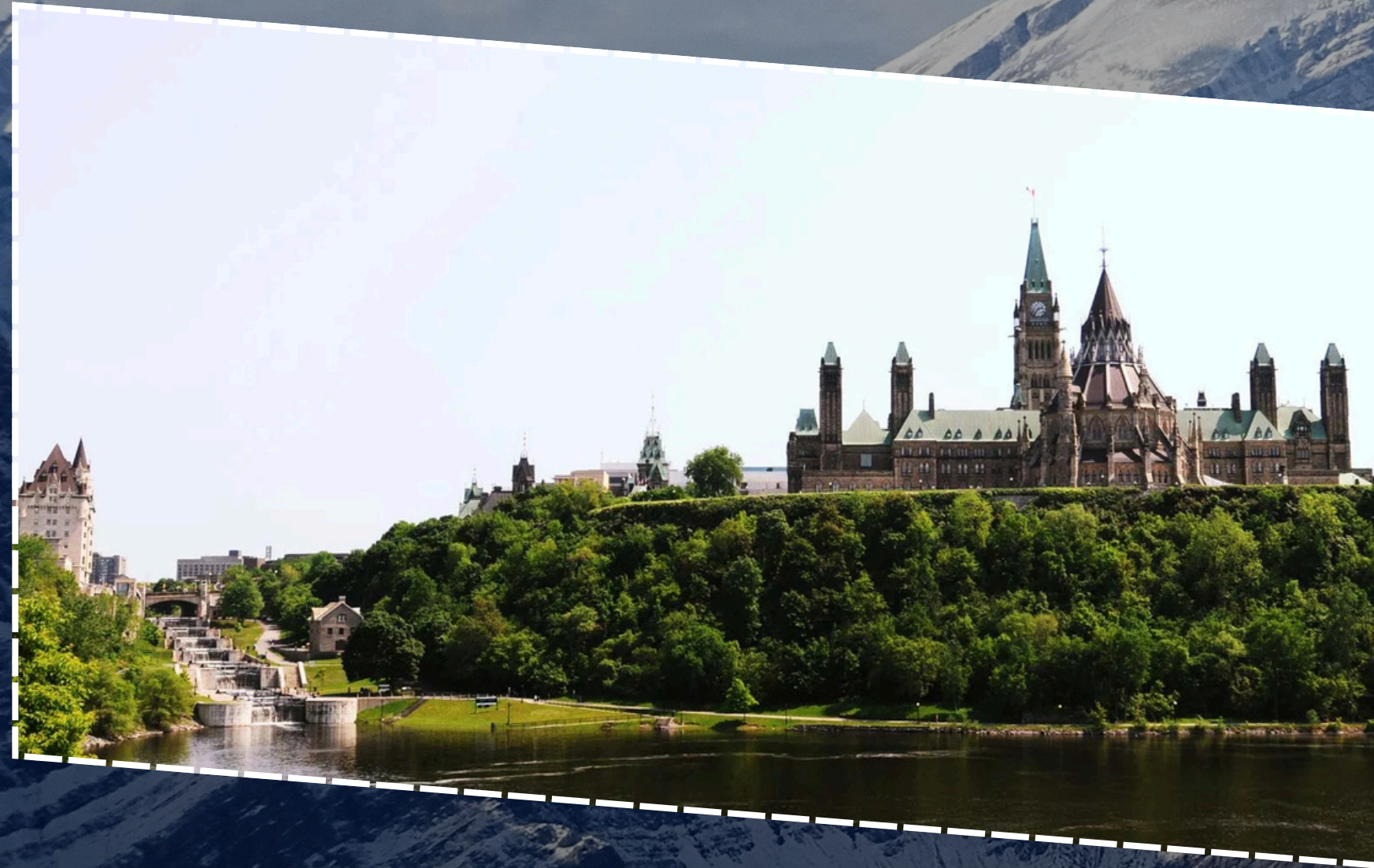
*Whistler is a premier year round resort municipality in British Columbia, Canada, located in the Coast Mountains roughly 125 km (78 mi) north of Vancouver. Famous for hosting the 2010 Winter Olympics, it features Whistler Blackcomb, one of North America's largest ski resorts, alongside a pedestrian only Village, renowned mountain biking and extensive outdoor, cultural and spa activities.*

## CHURCHILL (MANITOBA)

*Churchill, Manitoba is a remote subarctic town on the Hudson Bay known as the "Polar Bear Capital of the World." With a population of roughly 900, it is a major ecotourism hub accessible only by train or plane. Famous for its polar bear migration, beluga whales and northern lights, it offers unique Arctic experiences and serves as Canada's only deep sea Arctic port.*



# OTTAWA , ONTARIO



***Ottawa is the capital city of Canada located in southeastern Ontario on the border with Quebec, serving as the country's political, administrative and cultural heart. It is famous for landmarks like Parliament Hill, the Rideau Canal, a high concentration of national museums and its bilingual tech forward and green urban environment.***
