

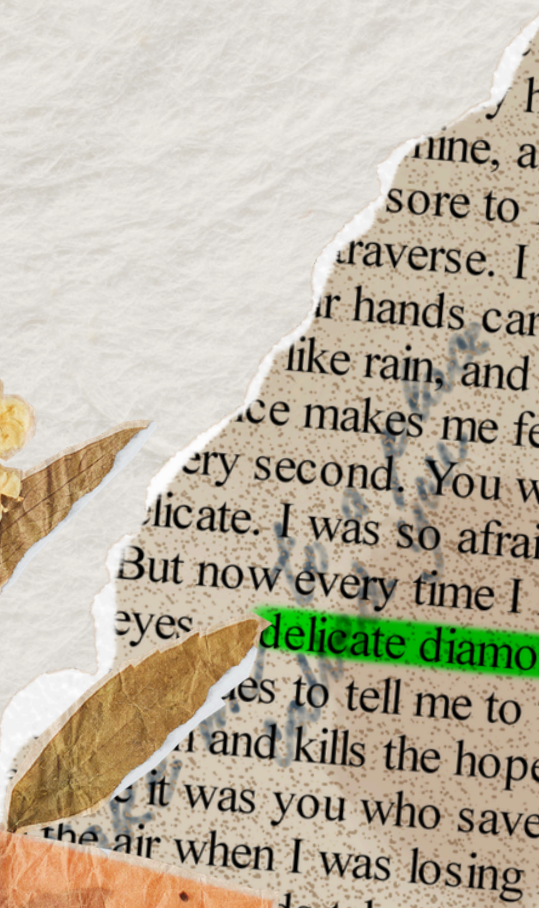
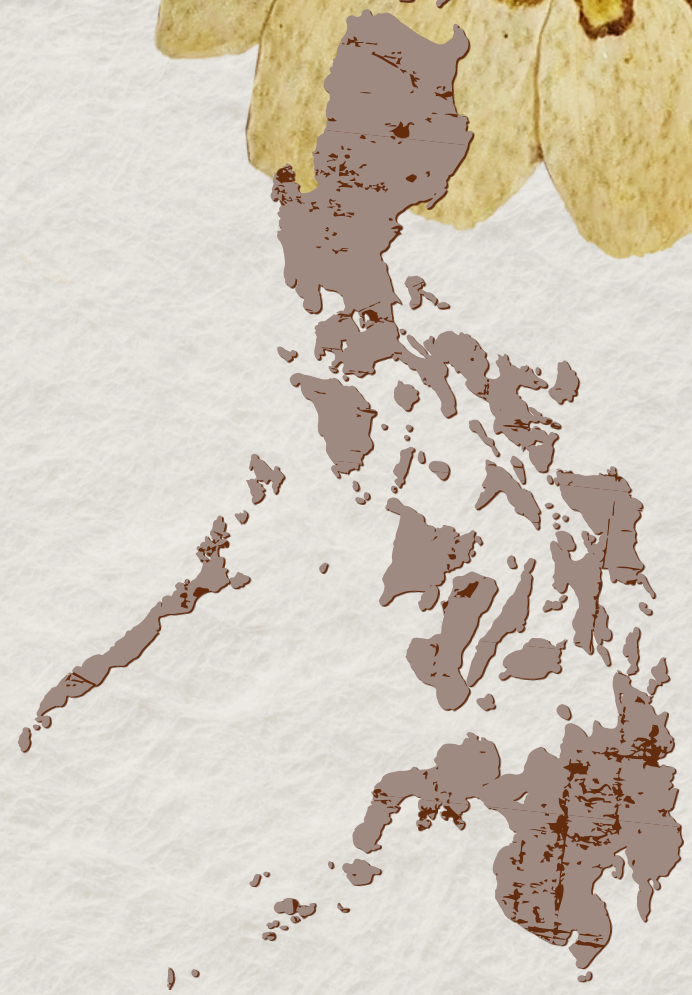

Philippines

The Philippines is a Southeast Asian archipelago of over 7,100 islands in the western Pacific Ocean characterized by a tropical climate, high biodiversity and a population of over 113 million. Known for its stunning beaches (like Palawan and Boracay) and Spanish American colonial history. it is a predominantly Roman Catholic nation with English as an official language.

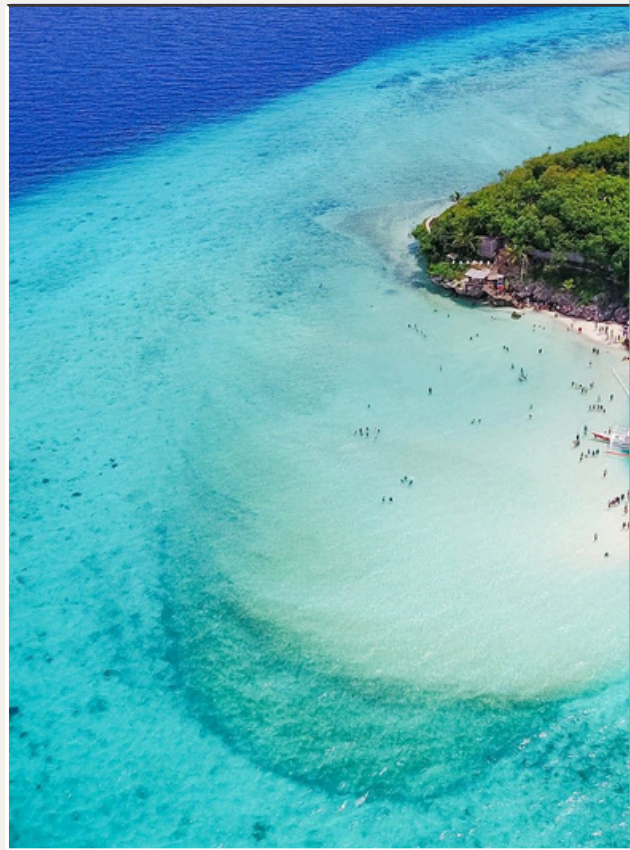


PALAWAN (EL NIDO / CORON)

Palawan specifically El Nido and Coron is a top Philippine destination renowned for dramatic limestone cliffs, crystal clear lagoons and pristine white sand beaches. El Nido offers iconic, towering karst scenery and lagoons (Big/Small Lagoon), while Coron is famous for shipwreck diving, Kayangan Lake and stunning underwater marine life.

BORACAY ISLAND

Boracay is a renowned 10.32 square kilometer tropical island in the Philippines, located off the northwest coast of Panay celebrated for its powdery white sand, turquoise waters and vibrant nightlife. Famous for its 4km long White Beach. it offers top tier diving, water sports and fine dining making it a premier tourist destination reachable primarily via Caticlan Airport.



CEBU

Cebu located in the Central Visayas region of the Philippines is a premier tourist destination known as the "Queen City of the South" and the country's oldest city. It offers a mix of urban sophistication rich Spanish colonial history including Magellan's Cross and stunning natural attractions like white sand beaches diving spots in Moalboal and waterfalls in Badian.



BOHOL

Bohol is a top Philippine eco tourism destination in Central Visayas famous for the unique Chocolate Hills, tiny Philippine Tarsiers and white sand beaches on Panglao Island. Offering a mix of adventure and history, it features diving, river cruises and colonial churches. Tagbilaran City serves as the capital and main hub.



MANILA

Manila is the vibrant densely populated capital and main port city of the Philippines acting as the nation's political, economic and cultural center. Situated on Luzon island along Manila Bay. It is known for blending Spanish colonial history especially in Intramuros with modern shopping, diverse food and bustling urban life.

DONSOL (SORSOGON)

Donsol a coastal municipality in Sorsogon, Philippines is globally renowned as the "Whale Shark Capital of the World" for its ethical natural habitat interactions with butanding (whale sharks) from November to June. Located in the Bicol region, it offers sustainable tourism featuring snorkeling with whale sharks, firefly lit river tours and mangrove tours.



BANAUE

Banaue, located in the Ifugao province of the Philippines, is world-renowned for its 2,000-year-old rice terraces carved into the mountains, often called the "Eighth Wonder of the World". As a UNESCO World Heritage site, it offers stunning, lush landscapes, indigenous Ifugao culture, and, for travellers, popular viewpoints and hiking in Batad.



SAGADA

Sagada is a serene cool climate town in the Cordillera region of Northern Luzon, Philippines renowned for its indigenous Kankana-ey culture, dramatic landscapes and ancient burial traditions like the hanging coffins. It is a premier destination for hiking, cave spelunking and sunrise viewing offering a peaceful rustic escape from city life.



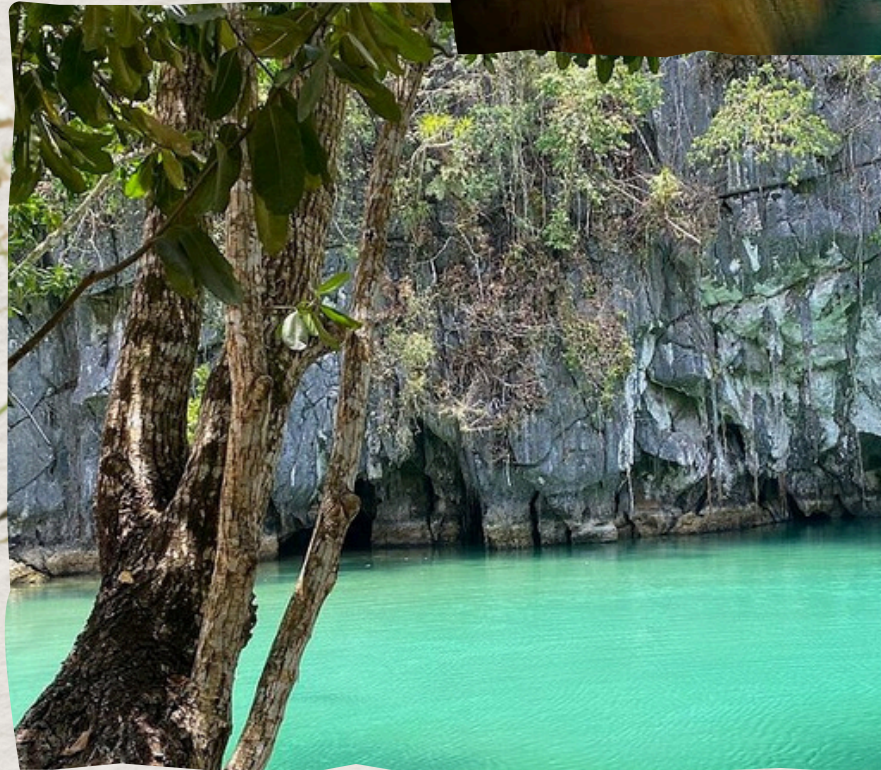
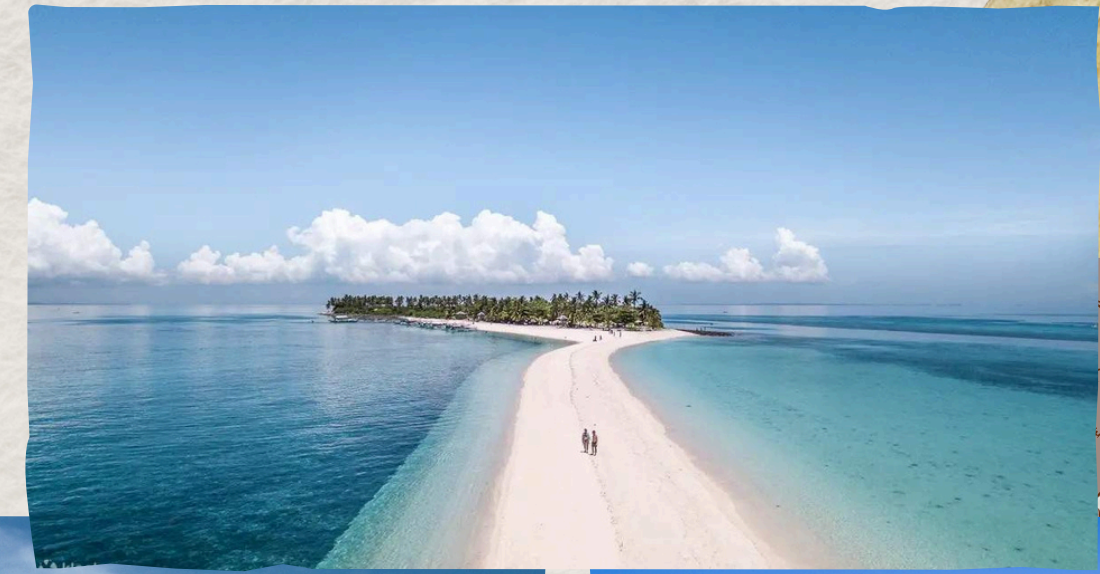
TAGAYTAY

Tagaytay is a popular second class city in Cavite Philippines, renowned as the "Second Summer Capital" due to its cool climate, high altitude and stunning views of Taal Volcano and Lake. Located just two hours from Manila. It is a premier weekend getaway famous for tourism, weddings and local delicacies like buko pie and bulalo.



DAVAO

Davao City located in Mindanao is the third largest city in the Philippines by population and the largest by land area, often recognized as one of the country's safest and cleanest cities. Known for its modern infrastructure, it serves as a major hub with international flight connections. It is famous for Mount Apo, the Philippines' highest peak and as the home of the Durian fruit.



Puerto Princesa Subterranean River National Park

The Puerto Princesa Subterranean River National Park in Palawan, Philippines is a UNESCO World Heritage Site (1999) and a New 7 Wonders of Nature (2012) recognized for its spectacular 8.2 km navigable underground river, one of the world's longest. Located in the Saint Paul Mountain Range, it features a unique mountain to sea ecosystem.

Malapascua Island

Malapascua is a tiny rustic island off the northern tip of Cebu, Philippines, globally renowned as the only place to dive with thresher sharks daily. Known for its white sand beaches, primarily Bounty Beach. it offers a laid back "tropical paradise" atmosphere ideal for diving and quiet escapes rather than nightlife.



Kawasan Falls

Kawasan Falls located in Badian, Cebu is a famous three tiered waterfall system renowned for its stunning turquoise blue, spring fed waters and lush jungle surroundings. It is a premier eco-tourism destination offering swimming, refreshing natural pools and popular canyoneering adventures with the main, largest and most popular cascade falling about 40 meters.



SIARGAO

Siargao is a tear drop shaped island in the Philippines, renowned as the country's "surfing capital". Located in Surigao del Norte, it features world class surf breaks (notably Cloud 9), white sand beaches, dense palm forests and tidal pools. It offers a laid back, rustic backpacker vibe, popular for surfing, island hopping and motorbike exploration.

VIGAN

Vigan City located in Ilocos Sur on Luzon island is a premier UNESCO World Heritage Site renowned as the best preserved Spanish colonial town in Asia. Founded in the 16th century, it features unique architecture blending Filipino, Chinese and European influences, cobblestone streets and kalesa (horse drawn carriage) rides.
