MALAYSIA

Malaysia is a Southeast Asian country divided into two main regions Peninsular Malaysia and East Malaysia (on Borneo) separated by the South China Sea. Known for its multicultural society (Malay, Chinese, Indian). it is a federal constitutional monarchy with Kuala Lumpur as its capital and Putrajaya as its administrative center.

KUALA LUMPUR

Kuala Lumpur (KL) is the capital and largest city of Malaysia serving as its economic and cultural hub. Founded in 1857 as a tin mining town, it has grown into a tropical multi ethnic metropolis. Famous for the iconic Petronas Twin Towers and Batu Caves. The city blends modern skyscrapers with colonial architecture, bustling street food markets and vibrant nightlife.



PETRONAS TWIN TOWERS

The Petronas Twin Towers in Kuala Lumpur Malaysia are 452 meter (1,483 ft) 88 floor skyscrapers designed by Cesar Pelli reflecting Islamic architecture. Completed in 1998 they were the world's tallest buildings until 2004 and remain the tallest twin towers. Key features include a two story skybridge (levels 41–42) an observation deck (level 86) and the Suria KLCC mall.



BATU CAVES

Batu Caves is a renowned 400 million year old limestone hill featuring a series of caves and Hindu cave temples in Gombak, Selangor, Malaysia just 13 km north of Kuala Lumpur. It is famously guarded by a 43 meter high Lord Murugan statue .the world's tallest and requires climbing 272 colorful steps to reach the main Temple Cave.



PENANG (GEORGETOWN)

George Town the capital of Malaysia's Penang state is a vibrant UNESCO World Heritage site known as the "Pearl of the Orient." Located on Penang Island, it serves as a top food destination, renowned for street art, multiculturalism and well preserved British colonial era architecture making it a major tourism hub.

CAMERON HIGHLANDS

The Cameron Highlands located in Pahang, Malaysia is a premier mountain retreat developed in the 1940s famous for its cool weather sweeping tea plantations and highland forests. Situated at about 1,500 meters above sea level, this popular destination offers scenic trekking, strawberry picking and a refreshing escape from the tropical heat with main towns including Tanah Rata and Brinchang.

LANGKAWI

Langkawi a duty free archipelago of 99 islands in Kedah, Malaysia is a premier UNESCO Global Geopark known for its lush jungles, limestone cliffs and popular white sand beaches like Pantai Cenang. Known as the "Jewel of Kedah," it offers attractions like the SkyCab cable car, Sky Bridge and Kilim Karst Geoforest Park.



BORNEO (SABAH & SARAWAK)

Malaysian Borneo comprising the states of Sabah and Sarawak (East Malaysia) is a biodiversity hotspot famous for ancient rainforests, orangutans and Mount Kinabalu. Located on the world's third largest island, it offers diverse wildlife, indigenous culture and pristine diving spots contrasting with the more urbanized West Malaysia.

MELAKA

Melaka (Malacca) is a UNESCO World Heritage city in Malaysia, renowned for its rich history, colonial architecture and Peranakan cuisine. Founded in 1396, it has been influenced by Portuguese, Dutch and British rule, creating a unique cultural blend. Located two hours from Kuala Lumpur, key attractions include Jonker Street, Dutch Square and riverside murals.

GENTING HIGHLANDS

Genting Highlands is a premier hilltop resort 1 hour from Kuala Lumpur (Pahang, Malaysia) offering a cool (18°C–24°C) escape, famous for casinos, theme parks and shopping. Key attractions include Genting SkyWorlds Outdoor Theme Park, Skytropolis Indoor Park, Genting Skyway cable car and Premium Outlets.

MELAKA

Melaka (Malacca) is a UNESCO World Heritage city in Malaysia, renowned for its rich history colonial architecture and Peranakan cuisine. Founded in 1396. It has been influenced by Portuguese, Dutch and British rule creating a unique cultural blend. Located two hours from Kuala Lumpur key attractions include Jonker Street, Dutch Square and riverside murals.



TIOMAN

Tioman Island (Pulau Tioman) is a lush volcanic island off Malaysia's east coast in Pahang famous for its turquoise waters, coral reefs and dense rainforest. A popular duty free, eco tourism destination. it features stunning beaches, hiking trails, snorkeling and diving. Key areas include Tekek, Salang, ABC and Juara.



PERHENTIAN ISLAND

The Perhentian Islands (Besar and Kecil) in Malaysia are a tropical paradise renowned for stunning white sand beaches, crystal clear turquoise waters and world class snorkeling and diving with sharks and turtles. Located off the northeast coast. they offer a tropical escape best visited between March and October for sunny warm weather.



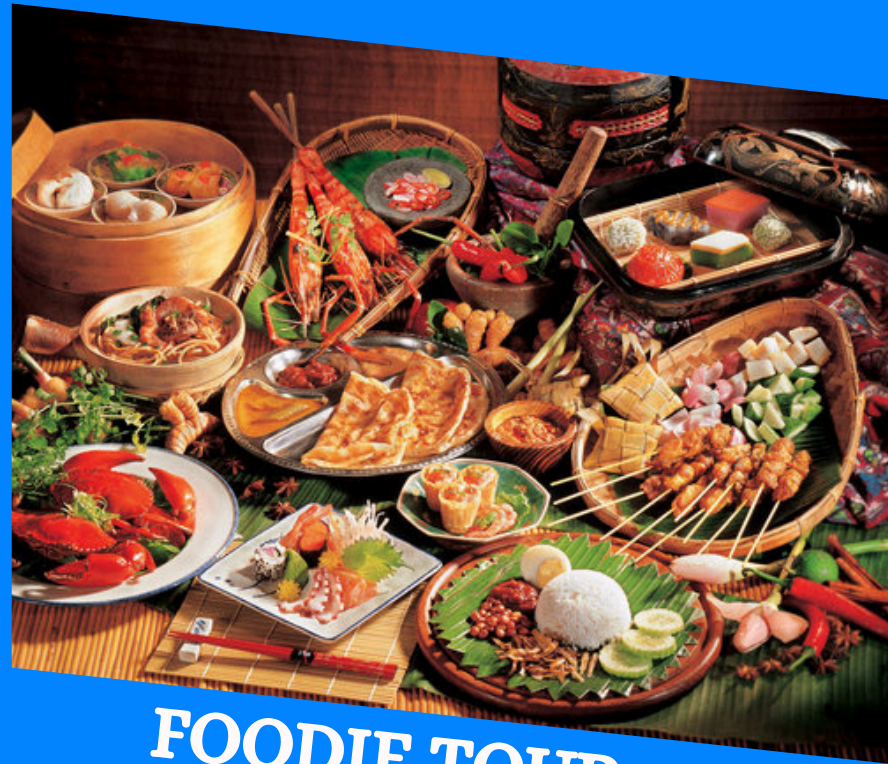
PANGKOR ISLAND

Pangkor Island is a duty free accessible island destination off Perak's coast in West Malaysia renowned for its laid back atmosphere, fishing villages and accessible beaches like Pasir Bogak and Teluk Nipah. Officially designated as a duty free island in 2020. it offers affordable popular getaways featuring snorkeling, hornbill feeding and local seafood.
